Program Description:

The Division of the Fire Marshal (DFM), Office of Research Services (ORS) serves as the NIH fire safety “Authority Having Jurisdiction” as defined by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and, in the capacity, provides final authoritative judgments required in the application and interpretation of current fire codes and other applicable standards, regulations, and policies regarding all aspects of fire safety at NIH. The DFM, ORS provides consultation and technical assistance to the NIH and the extramural biomedical research community regarding work practices and facility design and construction concepts that enhance fire safety and includes providing comprehensive fire protection engineering reviews of structure modification and new construction plans and proposals. In addition, the DFM, ORS provides fire safety information and training, develops methodology for assessing and mitigating fire hazards associated with biomedical research, conducts technical fire investigations, develops NIH policies and procedures regarding fire safety and conducts periodic fire safety surveys.

Expected Job Duties:

Work includes fire prevention inspection services, fire safety awareness promotion, and fire prevention consultation services. The successful candidate will conduct inspections to document and report fire safety related deficiencies in accordance with the NFPA 1, *Fire Code* and the NIH Design Requirements Manual. Inspections include a review of all fire protection systems (Active and Passive), portable fire extinguishers, means of egress, and hazardous operations within a given facility. Job duties include:

- Inspection Scheduling and Documentation
- Building Inspections
- Tent/Trailer and Temporary Facility Inspections
- Hazardous Work Permit Inspections & Monitoring
- Public Assembly Event Inspection
- Conduct Fire Safety Awareness Training
- Prepare Fire Protection Displays and Media Releases

Required Skills/ Education:

- Minimum of 5 years’ experience in fire inspection.
- Certified Fire Inspector III **or** Certified Fire Protection Specialist (CFPS) **or** a graduate of a two year degree program in Fire Science.
